WELCOME TO FR LIAM CASTLE: As Fr Mark announced last week we are preparing to welcome Fr Liam who will join Fr Mark and help him with the pastoral responsibility for the 3 parishes in Corby from early in September. It will be soon upon us! We will give more details of meetings that will be held in the coming weeks as we prepare for this major change for the Catholic Community in Corby. Fr Liam is one of our younger priests in the diocese and has been ordained 3 years. I am sure he will receive a warm welcome from us all.

BEST LAID PLANS....We were looking at the forecast over the last week and with threat of storms we reluctantly decided to cancel the planned parish barbecue this Sunday. We hope to arrange to have one towards the end of the summer.

MONDAY'S MASS: This Monday Mass will be held at 10.00am in St Brendan's school Hall, all parishioners are welcome and there will be tea & coffee in the Hall afterwards.

NEW WINESKINS DISCERNMENT PROCESS: Thank you to everyone who got involved with the listening process. **Bishop David** is returning to mark the midway point of the journey and to discuss the issues that have been raised. Bishop David will be attending the meeting this **Monday 21 July** which will be held in **St Brendan's school hall from 7.00 pm to 8.30pm**. All are welcome; please come along if you can and light refreshments will be provided.

CHILDREN'S LITURGY: This was called God's Little People in the past - young children who have not made their first Holy Communion are invited during the 11.00 am Mass to go to the parish room and reflect on a children's version of the gospel and have their own Liturgy of the Word. If you would like to help with this please let us know. All adults will need to have DBS clearance and we will be happy to help with this.

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION: We are going to follow the practice recommended by the diocese for children for First Holy Communion and Confirmation to be prepared within the parish by parish catechists and supported by the clergy. So for the children who are looking to celebrate the sacraments next year we will prepare them, those in Catholic Schools and those in State Schools, within the parish. This will consist of one Saturday morning a month and the classes will be held at St Patrick's Primary School. We will give dates and times in the next few weeks. I know this is a major change and we will be asking the families to commit to the programmes but it is also a wonderful way for the children to get to know each other throughout the parishes in Corby.
