**CHANGES IN OUR TOWN**: As we prepare for the major changes that will affect all the parishes in Corby we are embarking on a listening process. Mags Connolly, one of our parishioners, is chair of the Pastoral Area Council and she will be helping to promote the listening process with the other parish reps in the town and we would really like you to become involved in it. We will give further details in the coming weeks about how we will go about it. We believe the parishes will come together by the end of the summer. Let us work together to make it a success.

SVP PILGRIMAGE TO WALSINGHAM FOR THE SICK: The Pilgrimage is on Sunday 6th July. The day will include Mass, Anointing of the sick and Benediction. Cost for coach is £15pp, first two children are free, £5per/child thereafter for each family. As was last year pick up times are as follows; St Patrick's Church - 8am, St John Ogilvie Church -8:15am, St Brendan's Church - 8:30 am, Our Lady' Church - 8:40am. The program of the day is as follows; 1.45pm - Mass with Bishop Peter Collins. 3:15pm - Sacrament of the Sick. 4pm - Benediction. There is a cafeteria on site at Walsingham and there are facilities for people to eat their own packed lunch. We expect to return to Corby between 6:30 - 7pm. **FATIMA STATUE & RELICS VISIT:** The Centenary Pilgrim Virgin Statue of the Immaculate Heart of Mary and the relics of Saints Francisco and Jacinta Marto will visit Northampton Cathedral on Saturday, 21st June 2025. All are welcome for a special day of prayer, veneration, and reflection, including: Mass, Rosary for peace, Fatima film and talk, Brown Scapular enrolment, and Holy Hour. Bishop David will celebrate the Vigil Mass at 6:00pm.
