PARISH NOTICES

CORBY PARISHES: The clustering of the Corby parishes continues to progress well, and Fr Mark would like to thank everyone for their patience and understanding as these changes take place. As he mentioned at last weekend's Masses at Our Lady's, we must begin preparing for the possibility that Corby may, in the future, be served by only one priest. With this in mind, we have reviewed what is needed and what can reasonably be sustained in terms of Mass times and other services.

Currently, the Corby cluster offers two Saturday evening Masses, four Sunday morning Masses, and one Sunday evening Mass

Before Covid, Our Lady's held a single 10.00am Sunday Mass; the 8.30am Mass was introduced during the pandemic to allow for social distancing. It has now been decided that the 8.30am Mass at Our Lady's and the 9.00am Mass at St Brendan's will be combined into a single 8.45am Mass at St Brendan's. The new Sunday Mass schedule will be:

Saturday Evening

- 5.00pm Our Lady's
- 6.00pm St Brendan's

Sunday

- 8.45am St Brendan's
- 10.00am Our Lady's
- 11.30am St Brendan's
- 5.00pm St John Ogilvie's (unchanged)

This revised schedule ensures that one priest can cover all weekend Masses and provides greater flexibility should a priest be away or unwell. These changes will take effect from **Sunday**, **4th January**. We will continue to monitor and review the arrangement.

Readers, stewards, and Eucharistic Ministers: if these changes affect your availability and you would like to move to a different Mass time or church, please contact the parish office by mid December.

Thank you once again for your cooperation and understanding.

PARISH LISTENING PROCESS: Following this initiative in our parishes, a Discernment Group was formed to reflect on the feedback shared by parishioners. Our North Northamptonshire Pastoral Area - which includes Corby, Kettering, Wellingborough, Rushden, Thrapston, Oundle and Raunds - is more geographically dispersed than most, and as a result we are discerning the future at different paces. This is natural, as each of our communities has its own particular strengths and challenges. The Corby Discernment Group, made up of representatives from our three parishes, has been exploring a range of possible ways forward. In the New Year, we will hold an open meeting to which everyone will be invited, so that we can share proposals and discuss how our mission in Corby can continue to

grow, thrive and respond to both the challenges and opportunities ahead. Details of this meeting will be provided in the coming weeks.

CCTV: We have now installed cameras at Our Lady's to cover the Sacristies, front of the house and the back garden. This is so we can protect everyone using our buildings..

If anyone is interested in knowing more about the Catholic Faith, then you are encouraged to join in the RCIA/Journy in Faith Group on Monday evenings in the Parish Room at St Brendan's Church after the 7pm Mass. It is an opportunity for people to come and reflect on the faith in a relaxed setting. If you know someone who may be interested encourage them to come along or offer to come with them.

MARRIAGE MEETING: For couples who are planning to get married in one of the Catholic Churches in Corby, a Catholic Church abroad or a Church in another part of the country please come along to a marriage evening on Wednesday 3rd December at St Brendan's at 7.00pm. Fr Mark and Fr Liam will explain the procedures and the forms that need to be filled in. They will also outline the marriage course that needs to be completed online and answer any questions you may have. Please inform the parish office if you are planning to get married in one of the Churches in Corby.

THE CROWN OF ADVENT NOVENA: The unique Chaplet beads and Prayer Cards for this Novena will be blessed during the 10.00 am Holy Mass at Our Lady of Walsingham on Sunday 23rd November. Thereafter, they will be available to buy at a cost price of £2.00 from Janet Northing. Prayers for this Novena include the 'O Antiphons', the seven jewels of the Advent Crown, and it is being offered for the conversion of a loved one or loved ones. The Novena begins on Wednesday 17th December and finishes on Thursday 25th December.
