HE WAS LAST SEEN IN SOUTH FLORIDA IN MAPLEWOOD PLAYHOUSE'S PRODUCTION OF "THE 25TH ANNUAL PUTNAM COUNTY SPELLING BEE" AS LEAF CONEY BEAR AND GLORY DAYS AS WILL. Kim has also been seen in community theater productions such as Hot L Baltimore and Calendar Girls, as well as a professional production of The Addams Family. Her directing credits include Looking Glass Land, The Velveteen Rabbit and You're a Good Man Charlie Brown for Actor's Rep. In 2011 she started her own company, through which she produced and directed numerous productions including Little Women, Disney's Aladdin, Jr., Disney's Little Mermaid Jr., Beauty and the Beast, Into the Woods, Peter Pan, Tarzan, Oliver, Mary Poppins, Shrek the Musical and Tick Tick Boom. She is currently the Artistic Director at Maplewood Playhouse and her most recent directing credits include Godspell Jr., Frozen Jr., Matilda Jr., Six: Teen Edition, Hadestown Teen Edition, Little Mermaid Jr., and Annie Jr. for the Young Arts Conservatory as well as adult professional productions of Glory Days, The 25th Annual Putnam County Spelling Bee, 4000 Miles, Agnes of God, You're a Good Man Charlie Brown and The Last Five Years. For many years, Kim has been an adjudicator at several different district thespian festivals for both the middle school and high school levels as well as having the pleasure of adjudicating at the Florida State Thespian Festival in Tampa.

She studied vocals with Cathy Jean Giordano and was offered opportunities to perform at Carnegie Hall. Her passion for theater and dance was rekindled once her own children started showing interest in performing arts. 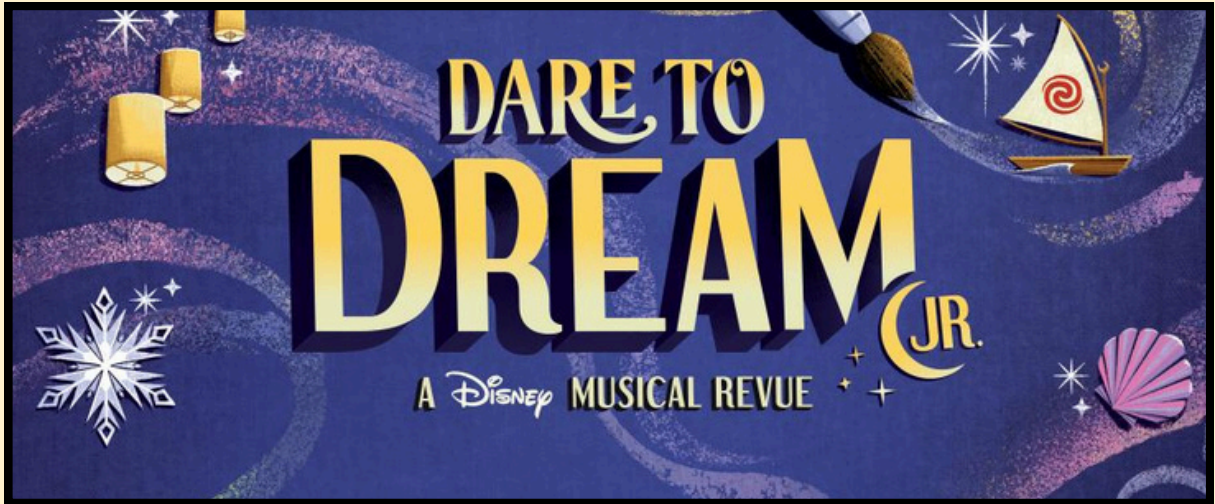
