By registering for this retreat, you acknowledge that you have thoroughly read, understood, and agree to the following Terms & Conditions:

1. Reservation & Payment

- A non-refundable deposit of \$500 is required to reserve your space
- Your reservation is not confirmed until the deposit has been received
- Payment plans are available if needed and will be discussed and finalized directly to you
- All final payments are due no later than 60 days prior to the Retreat start date
- Zelle, Venmo, ACH Transfers and Cash is accepted
- Any payments made online via CC are subject to additional fees
- You will receive recorded invoices as proof of payment(s)

2. Cancellation Policy

- Deposits are non-refundable

Please note, it is strongly recommended to purchase travel insurance that includes trip cancellation, medical coverage and travel interruption.
