Nebraska Craft Brewers Guild Industry Marketing Grant (2024-2025) - FINAL REPORT

This \$29,000 grant, awarded to the Nebraska Craft Brewers Guild by the Nebraska Craft Brewery Board, funded the **Drink Local** marketing campaign. The project focuses on promoting Nebraska's craft beer industry by encouraging consumers to "DrinkLocalNebraska" year-round, with an emphasis on October as "**Drink Local Month.**" Campaign efforts include the creation of marketing materials, social media promotion, branded merchandise, event infrastructure, and brewery engagement strategies designed to increase visibility and consumer loyalty to Nebraska-brewed products.

Industry Impact:

The **Drink Local** campaign strengthens Nebraska's craft beer industry by increasing consumer awareness, encouraging brand loyalty, and driving traffic to breweries and cideries across the state. By educating Nebraskans and visitors on the economic and social impact of supporting local breweries, the campaign builds stronger community connections and helps expand market reach for member businesses. These efforts contribute to sustained growth within the state's craft beverage sector and reinforce Nebraska's identity as a destination for quality, locally produced craft beer.

Nebraska Pint Day:

A new initiative introduced this year - Nebraska Pint Day - is an annual statewide celebration held on the first Tuesday of October, designed to showcase and support Nebraska's craft breweries and cideries. Participating locations offer limited-edition collectible pint glasses, with \$2 from each glass sold donated directly to the Nebraska Craft Brewers Guild to fund its mission of increasing independent brewing market share and fostering industry collaboration. The event also drives customers into taprooms on a traditionally slower day, helping breweries connect with new and returning customers while celebrating Nebraska-brewed products.

Program Value

Nebraska Pint Day delivers value on multiple levels: it serves as a **fundraiser** for the Guild, a **revenue booster** for participating breweries, and a **marketing initiative** that builds consumer excitement around local craft beer. By combining exclusive merchandise, in-person engagement, and statewide promotion, the event strengthens community connections, increases taproom traffic, and enhances overall awareness of Nebraska's craft brewing industry while directly funding future advocacy and industry growth efforts.
