

The City of Sun Prairie is located in northeastern Dane County just outside of Madison. From just 4,000 people when it was founded in 1958, this vibrant and growing community has committed to progressive development and improvement of new and existing infrastructure.

City staff issued a Request for bids (RFB) for a city hall facility-wide LED lighting upgrade. the RFB also included two alternate bids:

- one for access challenged lighting, which was be funded by a \$15,000 grant awarded from the public Service Commission's 2021 Energy Innovation Grant Program (EIGP)
- the second for the replacement of the second floor ceiling tiles

On top of energy and cost savings, Upper 90 worked closely with the City of Sun Prairie to help achieve their project sustainability goals, with landfill diversion, repurposing, as well as recycling. In total, these efforts diverted 6,672 pounds of what would have otherwise been waste.




Portion of Recycled Cardboard
