Day #1 Devotional - To Increase in Spiritual Hunger and Holiness:

As the New Year begins, ask the Lord to awaken your heart to His love. Pray for increased hunger to spend more time in prayer, worship, and God's Word. Psalm 51:10-12 Scripture References: Philippians 4:8-9, Joshua 1:8, 2 Timothy 2:15.

Meditation: How can I become more like Him?

Day #2 Devotional - To Draw Closer to the Lord:

Ask the Lord to reveal to you anything that would hinder your ability to come into His presence in a deeper way than you ever have before. Pray for the ability to see your sin as He sees it. Be brokenhearted over your sin and ask for forgiveness. Psalm 24:3-5 Scripture Reference: Romans 8:35-39, Hebrews 12:1-2.

Meditation: God knows we have struggles, and He has an answer.

Day #3 Devotional - Breaking Free of the Chains of Bondage:

Jesus has paid the price of redemption for all to be free. Embrace your newly found freedom, the chains are broken and the things that have held you in bondage are removed. Isaiah 58:6- 9 (MSG) Scripture References: Psalm 27:13-14, Isaiah 10:27.

Meditation: The truth shall make you free. What chains of bondage do you need to be free from?

Day #4 Devotional - To Walk in Wisdom and Revelation:

Ask the Lord to open your eyes to see Him more clearly and your ears to hear anything He desires to speak. Pray for a Spirit of wisdom and revelation that you might know Jesus more deeply and have a profound understanding of the hope that is in His heart for you. 1 Corinthians 2:9-16, Ephesians 1:17-18 Scripture

References: 1 Kings 19:11-13, Psalms 119:97-104, Proverbs 19:8.

Meditation: Ask the Lord to open your eyes to see Him more clearly and your ears to hear anything He desires to speak.

Day #5 Devotional - To Find and Fulfill Your Destiny:

The greatest joy, fulfillment, and success comes when we seek Him about the direction for our lives and commit to follow His plan for us. Scripture: Psalm 37:23-29 (NKJV) Scripture References: Joshua 1:3-6, Psalms 119:105-106, Daniel 10:12.

Meditation: Ask the Lord to share with you the plan that He has for your life. Pray that He will give you the next step in His Divine plan for your life and commit that you will follow His plan, for you, forever.

Day #6 Devotional - To Experience Fresh Encounters:

Invite the Lord to visit your family (spouse, children, mother, father, brothers, sisters, etc.) in a fresh new way in 2023. Pray that this year you, your family, and your close friends will encounter the holiness and sovereign power of God that will leave each one changed by His presence and more committed to His Kingdom.

Scriptures: Psalm 145:9-19 (NIV) Scripture References: Psalm 78:4-7, Deuteronomy 6:6-12.

Meditation: Ask the Lord to help you seek out a fresh renewal with a new hunger for His righteousness and His ways. Pray: Teach me to think like you so that I may be all that you would have me to be.

Day #7 Devotional - To Experience Revival:

Pray for revival to break out in your community, in schools, government, business, and congregations. Ask the Lord to raise up dedicated Christians who will become a voice to change our community and our nation. Scripture Reference: Psalm 85, Psalm 147:1-11, Revelation 21:5-6. *Meditation:* Praise God. He will create in you the victory and elevate you to a new level for His glory.

Many have been discouraged by others who are in the race. All are running for the same prize, eternal life. Many are running at a fast pace, others are strong runners. We all get the prize if we endure to the end

We have a great example of a runner before us. There are some requirements to run the race. The writer of Hebrews 12 says Let us lay aside every weight and sin that besets us.

We know that we cannot run the race if sin is in our lives. Our Lord died for our sins. He will forgive us if we ask him. God abhors sin. Proverbs 6:16 says a proud look a lying tongue, and hands that shed innocent blood, an heart that deviseth wicked imaginations, feet that be swift in running to mischief, a false witness that speaks lies, and he that sows discord among the brethren.

Everything is not a sin, but some things are weights. What are your weights? Some things we may not think are weights. Some of our friends may be a weight. Places we attend may be a weight. 

How did Scrooge win the football game? The ghost of Christmas passed!






Experiencing God in 2024 (Ten Principles)

- 3. Principle 3: Waiting Prayer: "Lord, I am waiting with expectation for you." Scriptures: Psalm 37:7; Psalm 62:1; Isaiah 40:31; Lamentations 3:25
- 4. Principle 4: Coming Prayer: "Lord, here I come. I am answering your call. I come to you because I love you and I want the best that you have for me." Scriptures: Matthew 11:28-29; Luke 10:39
- 5. Principle 5: Drinking Prayer: "Lord, I am thirsty for you." Scriptures: Matthew 5:6; John 4:13-14; John 6:35b; John 7:37-38
