Please read before getting permanent jewelry:

Permanent Jewelry is affixed through a welding process with inherent risks to the following:

Eyes. It's important not to view the arc welder without protective eyewear during the welding process. Protective eyewear will be provided or you can choose to look away.

Skin. A protective leather strip will be placed between your skin and the jewelry being welded. The welder may emit small sparks during the welding process. Since the welding process uses an electrical arc to melt the metal, please be aware there is a slight chance of an electrical shock.

Body Parts. It is not recommended for a person who has permanent jewelry to use mechanical machinery. There is a risk associated with machines that spin, turn, wrap, pinch, and/or roll. The jewelry could get caught and cause injury or amputation.

Please understand these risks prior to getting permanent jewelry and know that Missing Link Jewelry IIc is not liable for accidents should something happen.
