



**Bulletin Blurb for the Epiphany of the Lord**

Praised be Jesus Christ!

The Magi have finally arrived at the scene of our Lord's Nativity, and they not only bring with them gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh, but something far more profound. These three kings from the mysterious east bring along with them the celebration and revelation that Jesus Christ has come into the world as Savior for all peoples alike: Jewish, Greek, gentile, slave, free, man, woman, child. Jesus Christ is not only King of the Jewish people but King of all peoples. The word "epiphany" itself comes from the Greek meaning, "to shine upon" or "manifestation" and Jesus manifests as the light of all nations. This manifestation is also revealed at Christ's own baptism by Saint John the Baptist as the Spirit of God descended like a dove with the voice of the Heavenly Father saying, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased." No revelation is as clear as the voice of the Heavenly Father Himself! This proclamation is echoed even in our own liturgical celebration. While it has fallen out of practice in many churches since the modernization of scheduling and calendars, there is an ancient practice that takes place on the Feast of the Epiphany of the Lord: the Epiphany Proclamation. This ancient custom of announcing the moveable feasts for the upcoming year normally takes place after the Gospel but before the homily. The Church wants to ensure that these important celebrations, which are the physical manifestation of the historical and theological truths that we celebrate, are not missed by any of God's faithful. The God of the entire universe became matter in order that we may worship Him with matter; whether that matter is our own flesh and blood in the physical worship or if that matter is with those sacramentals that He has given us, we worship with the whole of our lives nonetheless. This Feast of Epiphany is a powerful time to pray for and bless your own homes and families with the powerful tools that we have been given such as epiphany chalk and water blessed during Epiphany. The light of the Lord's birth is a revelation that will never fade, certainly not in the lives of all of us who call St. Joseph in Danbury our home. God bless you all and have a very blessed Epiphany.
