Dear parishioners and friends of St. Joseph Parish,

Summer is a time when many parishioners take vacation time from work. We hope all those who have free time can experience refreshment, rest, and the joy of quality time with family and friends.

This summer, our Parish Team and I will be busy preparing our Church and School for the new academic and Faith Formation year in September, and we are very excited about our plans.

We anticipate the beginning of the stained-glass restoration project. As you know, an extensive "Stained Glass Window Condition Analysis" was prepared by Julie L. Sloan, who is the best of the best in her field.

Phase One of this project will begin in the July/August timeframe. It will include the removal of the St. Cecilia Rose Window on the facade of the Church, the four tall windows in the Church towers also on the facade of the Church; the seven windows in the chancel above the altar; the Annunciation window next to the side entrance, and the St. Joseph window in the side altar, as well as the windows in the Church Hall.

Clagnan Stained Glass Studio in Wall Township, New Jersey, was awarded the contract for the restoration work. This stained-glass Studio comes with an impressive list of churches where they have worked, including three prominent New York City churches: St. Vincent Ferrer Church, Trinity Church Wall Street, and The Riverside Church.

This summer, there will also be major upgrades to our Playground and Meditation Trail. We are blessed with these open spaces on our city campus. My own experience growing up in Gettysburg, Pa., with two national parks very close to my home helped me to appreciate observing the natural world and its beauty as a child, and we want that experience for our young people and adults, as well.

I am concluding now with a brief meditation from Thomas Merton, O.C.S.O., one of the best-known spiritual writers of the 20th century. The words of this Cistercian monk capture the experience of seeing the footprints of God in His creation. Enjoy!

"O Lord, how manifold are your works! In wisdom you have made them all; the earth is full of your creatures" (Psalm 104:24).

To deliver oneself up, to hand oneself over, entrust oneself completely to the silence of a wide landscape of woods and hills, or sea, or desert; to sit still while the sun comes up over that land and fills its silences with light. To pray and work in the morning and to labor and rest in the afternoon, and to sit still again in meditation in the evening, when night falls upon that land and when the silence fills itself with darkness and with stars. This is a true and special vocation. There are few who are willing to belong completely to such silence, to let it soak into their bones, to breathe nothing but silence, to feed on silence, and to turn the very substance of their life into a living and vigilant silence."

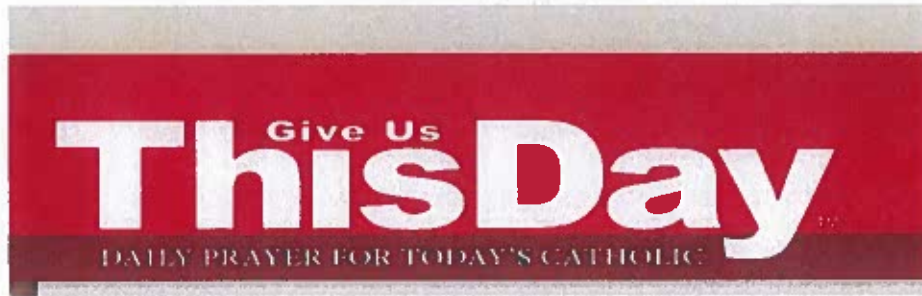

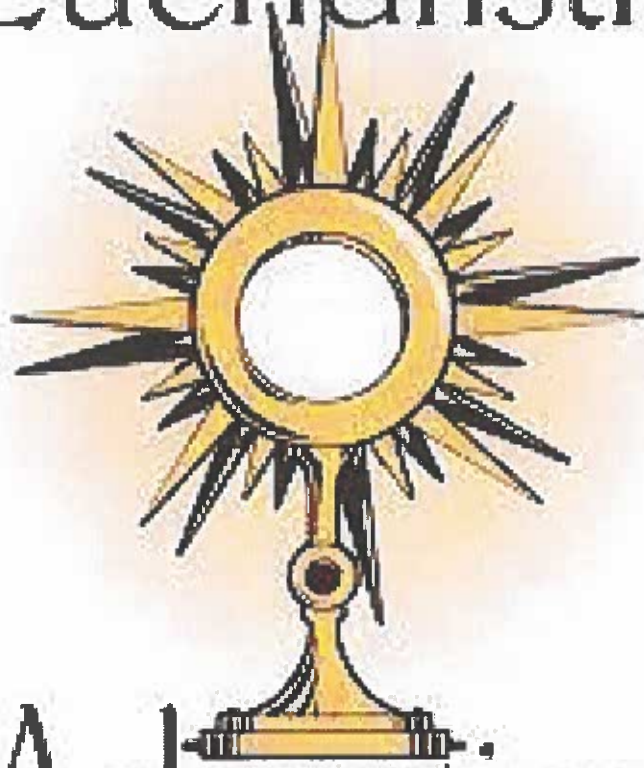
