

#### Bulletin Blurb for the 16th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Praised be Jesus Christ!

We live in an exceedingly busy culture. Growing up, it was far easier to disconnect; the phone was connected to the wall, the only computer I knew of was located in my school, mail came in letter form once a day, and being on "timeout" was actually a punishment (there was nothing to do in my bedroom!). Is it really difficult to wonder why Jesus exhorts Martha in the Gospel today to take notice of how Mary is interacting with Him? We all want to love and serve the Lord, and this is a beautiful thing, but how much time do we spend with Him, as opposed to doing things for Him?

The Benedictines motto is Ora et Labora, which translates as, "Pray and Work". Pray AND work. Their work, however important it may be, is not the same thing as their prayer. When we equate these things, we tend to slack on the prayer part of this motto. Time spent in prayer may feel like a passive activity, but nothing could be farther from the truth. There is nothing more important and more rewarding than "wasting your time" with Jesus in prayer. Take the time today to assess how often you make intentional time to be with Jesus in prayer or how often you spend time in the church before the Blessed Sacrament. We may do many amazing things for the Lord or in His name, but the hope is that what Jesus says about Mary in the Gospel today, He too says of us: that we too have "chosen the better part...".




