

#### Bulletin Blurb for the 17th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Praised be Jesus Christ!

"And I tell you, ask and you will receive; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks, receives..." Really, Lord? Is that true? I am certain that each and every person who has gone to the Lord in prayer, asking for something, has come across the Gospel today and asked themselves, is this really true? "I have been praying for years for my children's conversion, or the health of a loved one, or for an addiction to be remedied, and I have not seen any change whatsoever!"

It is always necessary to look at the text of the Sacred Scripture in its entirety because to take little snippets of the text means that we lose out on the fact that Jesus was not just giving lectures to his disciples but rather, he was trying to move minds and hearts in their entirety. Immediately before Jesus tells His disciples that whatever they ask for in prayer, they will receive, He tells a parable that highlights the importance of perseverance. Perseverance in prayer is the key to embracing the truth of Jesus' promise in the Gospel today.

It is always important to remember that God's time might not exactly be our own and even if the subject of our prayer is as important as the conversion of a loved one or their health, God's time is far more important than our own. Remaining persistent in prayer, even if it has been 50 years or more, is the key to this promise. Bear up with the burden of a prayer seemingly unanswered and embrace Christ's promise that even if in your lifetime you see no visible change, that He is working miracles in His own time. Saint Augustine once wrote of his mother, Saint Monica, "Lord, you did not do what she (St. Monica) was asking of you so that you could do what she always asked of you." The Lord knows best and perseverance in prayer is among the greatest signs of our trust in Him.




