**ADULT BIBLE STUDY  
THE ACTS OF THE APOSTLES****Coming this Fall, Register by September 28**

All interested parishioners (and guests) are invited to participate in the **upcoming session of our adult Bible study program.**

Acts, written by St. Luke, is the companion piece to his Gospel. The first half of Acts presents the Ascension of Jesus, the descent of the Holy Spirit, and the subsequent actions of St. Peter and the other Apostles as they converted people to Christianity in Jerusalem.

The second half of Acts concentrates on the conversion of St. Paul and his missionary trips to convert Gentiles. Throughout, it is inspiring to see the Holy Spirit in action among some familiar saints who are shown to be very human.

As we have in the past, we will be employing a nationally known program "Little Rock Scripture Study", published by The Liturgical Press. This is a recently updated presentation. We will break our study into two sections. **The first section (the first 15 chapters of Acts) will be presented during this coming October and November.** The second section (Acts chapters 16 through 28) will be presented in February and March of next year.

Participation in the program will entail some home study, and then the group meets each week to discuss the readings. Each session will take place on **Tuesday, from 7:00 to approximately 8:30 p.m., in the Carmen Buck Religious Education Building.** The final schedule will be determined by the participants as the year progresses.

Since the program requires the purchase of books, it is important to know the number of participants. For this reason, all interested parishioners (and guests) high school age and above are invited to contact Deacon Timmel for further information about the program and to register not later than September 28. Books will then be ordered and the final meeting dates will be announced. Two books will be needed to complete both sessions. The cost of both books is estimated to be approximately \$35.00 for each participant.
