

<u>Bulletin Blurb</u> for the Twenty-Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Praised be Jesus Christ!

With everything going on in the world it can be very easy to fall into despair about all of the violence, the hatred, and the persecution. God gave us free will and while free will allows us to love each other fully, it also allows us to commit heinous crimes against our fellow man. It is in what allows us to harm one another that is also our hope. In the second reading this Sunday, Saint Paul writes to Timothy saying, "you, man of God, pursue righteousness, devotion, faith, love, patience, and gentleness. Compete well for the faith." It is clear that it is not about not doing bad things but rather, it is about the pursuit of the Good.

We, as a society, tend to turn towards policies for hope: "if this or that bill is passed, everything would be better" or "this law would change everything". Policies and laws are meant to be an aid in our personal and familial pursuit of the Good. It is perfectly reasonable to be concerned. especially when it comes to our children, but despair is only of the devil. We heed the words of Jesus Himself when He says, "I have said this to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world you have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world." Pray hard for our world, pray hard for the conversion of so many who have succumb to acts of violence as their method of bringing about change, and pray for all of those who have been the target of that violence, that they may know the true and lasting peace of our God who promises that this life...this world, is not the end.

SPONSOR CERTIFICATE GUIDELINES

Our Parish receives many requests for Sponsor Certificates from people who have been asked to be a Godparent at a Baptism or a Sponsor at a Confirmation. This Certificate verifies that you are an active Catholic, a member of this parish and eligible for this honor.

Being a Godparent or a Sponsor is not just a family or social relationship, as important as these may be. It is a profound spiritual responsibility which entails witness and commitment and there are several requirements:

- 1. The Godparent/Sponsor is to be more than sixteen years of age.
- (S)He is to have received the Sacraments of Baptism, First Communion and Confirmation and live a life of faith which befits the role to be undertaken.
- If married, the Sponsor/Godparent must have been married according to the laws of the Church.
- 4. Is neither the father nor the mother of the person.

For the Pastor to issue a Sponsor Certificate:

- You need to be a currently registered member of our parish.
- 2. You worship here regularly.
- 3. You are requesting the Sponsor Certificate for *yourself*. Please do not ask a parent, spouse or other person to do this for you.
- 4. Sponsor Certificates will not be signed or issued before, or after, Mass.

Please call the Rectory at 203-748-8177 (Option #2) at least 3 weeks in advance of when a Sponsor Certificate is needed.
