

Bulletin Blurb for the Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome

Praised be Jesus Christ!

Today, in the year 324, marks the anniversary of the dedication of the cathedral church of Rome, on land owned by the Laterani family, by Pope St. Sylvester I. Honored as the episcopal seat of the pope as bishop of Rome, in the same way that our own bishop, Bishop Frank Caggiano, calls St. Augustine Cathedral his episcopal seat as bishop of the Diocese of Bridgeport. According to an inscription which Pope Clement XII place there, this church is the "mother and head of all church of Rome and the world" ("omnium ecclesiarum Urbis et Orbis mater et caput"). Residence of the popes from the fourth century until their moving to Avignon in 1309, site of five ecumenical councils, Pope Innocent X commissioned the present structure in 1646. Beneath its high altar rests the remains of the small wooden table on which, according to tradition, St. Peter celebrated Mass. This church was dedicated to the Savior and later to John the Baptist.

It may seem a strange thing to have an entire feast day dedicated to a mere building, especially when this feast day can be "weighed" against the feast days of saints and martyrs. This visible symbol of the universal Church calls us to look toward the house of God in the new Jerusalem, toward which the earthly Church is on constant and continual pilgrimage. We also honor, pray, and give thanks to all of the Veterans of our armed forces this coming Tuesday, November 11th. I would venture to guess that if you were to ask a Veteran if physical places are important, be they the battle grounds or the safety of their own homes, that they would respond with a resounding "yes!". The Basilica of St. John Lateran in Rome has been a battleground for the faith since the fourth century and continues to be a symbol of all of those who have come before us to defend the faith but also, promote and spread the Gospel message to the whole world. May the Lord keep this building, and all that it symbolizes, safe until He sees fit to come again!

St. Joseph Church's GIVING TREE


