WORDS OF ASSURANCE:

When we confess our sinful ways, God abundantly pardons. In the name of Jesus Christ, you are forgiven. In the name of Jesus Christ, we are all forgiven. **Glory to God!**

By one Spirit we are all baptized into the one body. Let us then pursue the things that make for peace and build up our common life.

May the peace of our Lord Jesus Christ continually be with us all!

THANKSGIVING AND COMMUNION:

May the Lord be with us as we lift our hearts to the Lord.

May God hear us as we give thanks to the Lord our God.

It is right to praise you, Lord. It is right, and a good and joyful thing, Always and everywhere to give thanks to you, Holy God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. From the rising of the sun to its setting your name is praised among all peoples.

Therefore, we praise you. In our hearts we join with your people on earth and all the company of heaven in a constant hymn to the glory of your name: Holy, holy, holy, Lord, God of power and might! Heaven and earth are Full of your glory. Hosanna in the highest!

Hosanna in the highest! Blessed is the One who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest!

You are holy, Almighty One! Blessed are you, Jesus Christ! In the power of the Spirit you created all things, blessed them, and called them good. You called to yourself a people to make your mercy and truth known in all the world. We betrayed your calling;

remembrance of me." You did the same with the cup after the supper, saying, "This cup that is poured out is the new covenant in my blood."

Blessed Trinity, in remembrance of all you have done to save us, we offer ourselves to you in praise and thanksgiving as a holy and living sacrifice, in union with Christ's offering for us, as we proclaim the mystery of our faith:

Christ has come among us. Christ has died. Christ has risen. Christ abides with us. Christ will come again.
