Sermon Review:

• What do you think about the following summary of the signs and problems with being a people pleaser?

Signs of being a people-pleaser include struggling to say "no," over-apologizing, avoiding conflict, difficulty setting boundaries, needing constant validation, and feeling responsible for others' feelings. People-pleasers often prioritize others' needs above their own, leading to exhaustion, stress, and resentment as their own needs are neglected. They may also fear disappointing others or being rejected, which fuels their desire to be liked and accepted. people-pleasing is a self-serving behavior to gain external validation and maintain personal safety.

- o How is being a people pleaser in reality being a self-pleaser?
- What might be the differences between being a God-Pleaser and Pharisaic Legalism?
