A tax rate of \$0.0153 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of Upper Sabine Valley Solid Waste Mgmt Dist..

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2025 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Upper Sabine Valley Solid Waste Mgmt Dist. from the same properties in both the 2024 tax year and the 2025 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that Upper Sabine Valley Solid Waste Mgmt Dist. may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that Upper Sabine Valley Solid Waste Mgmt Dist. is proposing to increase property taxes for the 2025 tax year.

A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON September 15, 2025 AT 5:30 pm AT Wood County Airport Conference Room.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, Upper Sabine Valley Solid Waste Mgmt Dist. is not required to hold an election at which voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the Upper Sabine Valley Solid Waste Management District of Upper Sabine Valley Solid Waste Mgmt Dist. at their offices or by attending the public hearing mentioned above.
