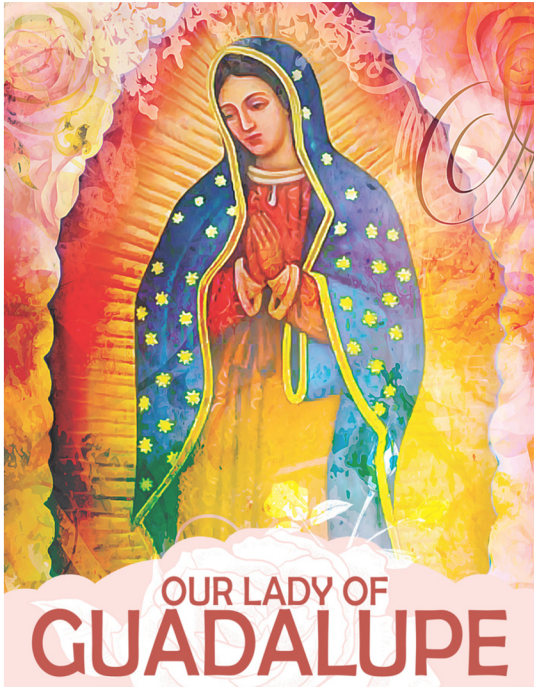

Our Lady of Guadalupe refers to the 1531 apparition of the Virgin Mary to Saint Juan Diego on Tepeyac Hill in present-day Mexico City. Revered as a powerful symbol of faith, compassion, and cultural identity, she is depicted on Juan Diego's miraculously imprinted tilma—an image that remains at the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe. The Patroness of the Americas, her feast day is December 12th.

Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe hace referencia a la aparición de la Virgen María a San Juan Diego en 1531 en el cerro del Tepeyac, en la actual Ciudad de México. Venerada como un poderoso símbolo de fe, compasión e identidad cultural, su imagen está plasmada en la tilma de Juan Diego, un manto que se conserva en la Basílica de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe. Patrona de las Américas, su festividad se celebra el 12 de diciembre.
