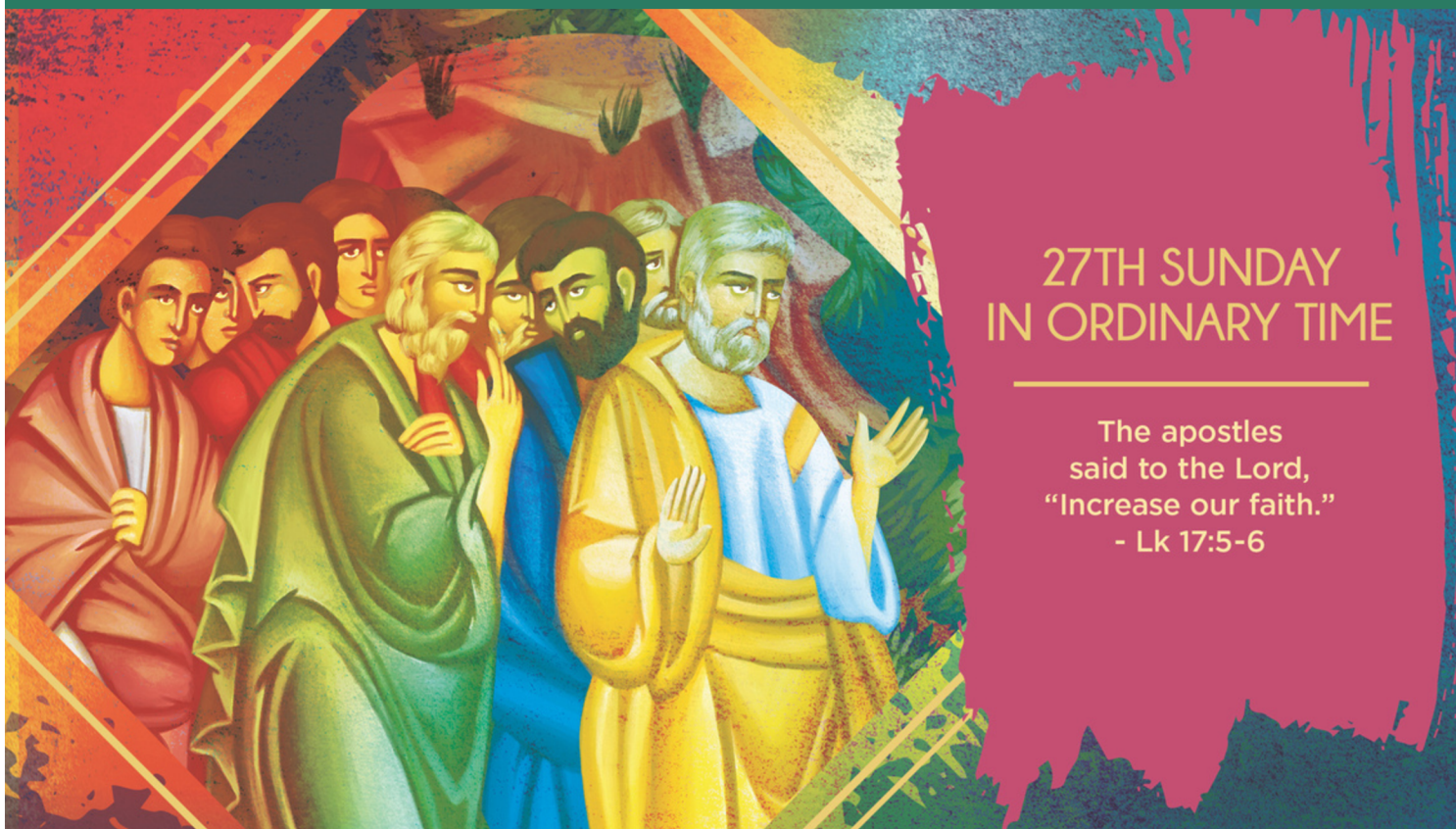

Every First Saturday of the Month.

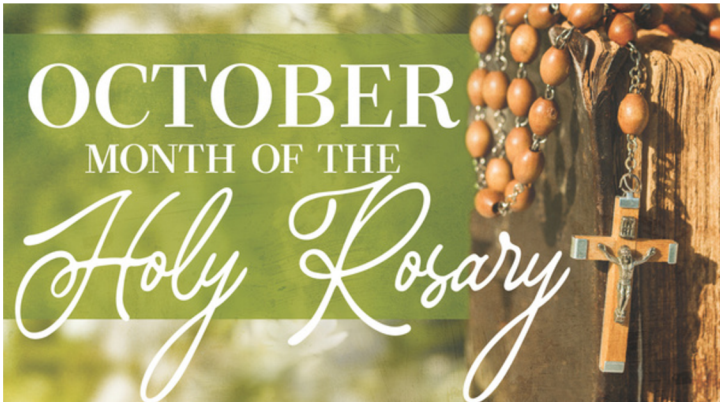
Please call the parish office three months prior to anticipated baptism date in order to review requirements. Sponsors (Godparents) must be practicing Catholics.
