Por favor llame a la oficina parroquial tres meses antes del bautizo para revisar los requisitos. Los padrinos deben ser Católicos practicantes.

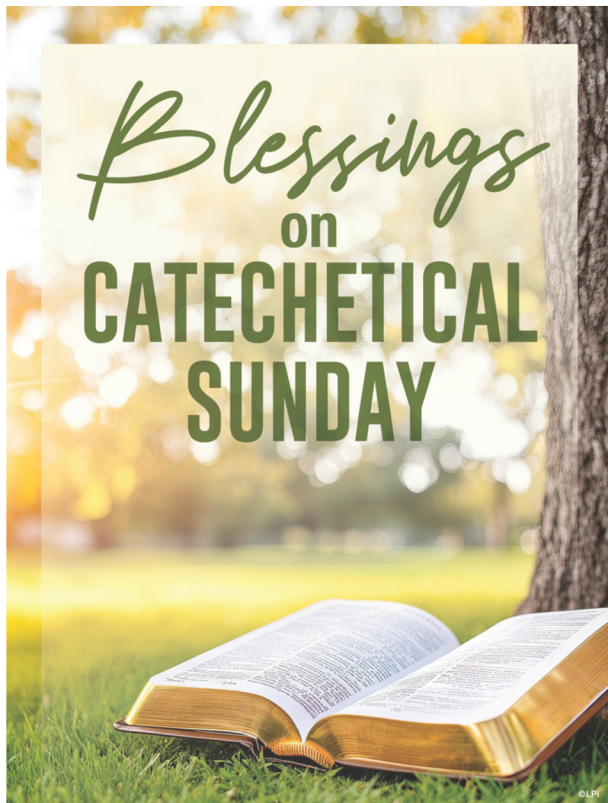
Quinceañeras
