What are the Requirements to Become an AARA Member?

01.

Generate the majority of annual income from providing roofing services

02.

Hold a regional/city business license (will be annually reviewed and verified)

03.

Be an established business entity for a minimum of five years

04.

Carry a minimum of two million dollars liability insurance & torch on insurance if applicable (will be annually reviewed and verified)

05.

Have a valid WCB number & clearance letter (will be annually reviewed and verified)

06.

Install to the current Alberta Building Code as a minimum standard

07.

Be COR or SECOR certified (If not, yet certified, will need to be completed within the 1 year probationary period)

08.

For Contractors: The AARA will conduct project observations, to determine if your workmanship meets Alberta Building Code. We will require a list of recently completed projects that a certified inspector will do an unannounced inspection.
