The January HOA monthly meeting was held via Zoom due to inclement weather and numerous Board members being out of town. Thanks to those residents who joined online. The Board is discussing whether to have more Zoom calls during winter months going forward.

Recreation: As we experienced warm and dry afternoons in December and January, the courts saw pickleball & basketball use. New brooms and a roller are on the way. The picnic area above the playground is in the process of being refaced; it's almost complete and looks great.

Pool: The Board is receiving bids from companies to re-plaster the pool prior to opening in May. Between recommendations from the Pool Committee (thanks Andrew), Perfect Pools, residents and the Reserve Report, this work is #1 on the list of expenditures for 2024.

Social: Thanks to everyone on the Social Committee who helped make the holiday party a fun event for the community, and thanks to those who attended! The clubhouse was beautifully decorated and a very warm place to gather on a cold night. The sounds of horses pulling the sleigh could be heard for blocks. It was a joy to see so many of the kids in SouthPark!

Clubhouse: The 2023 summary of clubhouse usage: we saw a total of 77 uses in 2023 (29 general uses, 19 by the Dolphins, 12 Board meetings, 8 Men's Book Club, 7 Ladies' Book Club, 2 SouthPark events). A 75" TV has been installed above the fireplace and has come in handy at HOA meetings and for those incorporating slide shows into their meetings. The bi-fold closet doors that are barely hanging on their hinges are scheduled to be replaced soon.

Grounds: JBK completed their final community clean up in December. Advanced Concepts has been out a couple of times to clear snow. Once cleared our walks have been drying fast and there are very few problem spots considering this time of year. Guidelines for clearing snow are general and can be modified depending on the type of storm, the time of the winter month and temperature. Our approved snow clearing policy is: one inch has Advance Concepts clearing the walks on the south side of W Long Ave, the shaded walk area across from the Clubhouse (W Long) and the walk along Mineral (to accommodate City of Littleton requests); two inches for the remaining sidewalks throughout the community; four inches for townhome alleys.

The dog bag stations continue to see plenty of use. The grounds look pretty good, so thank you to those who are picking up after their pets and allowing our grounds to stay nice throughout the winter! SouthPark went through more than 40,000 dog waste bags in 2023.


