

# 2026 5-Day Club FAQ's

## What is a 5-Day Club?

A 5DC is a daily week-long summer backyard Bible club for children led by trained Christian teens from local churches here in Hawaii. Each days program includes 60 minutes of games, song, engaging Bible stories, scripture memory, and more!

## When are 5-Day Clubs held?

5-Day Clubs are held throughout the summer. Listed below are the weeks available to host a 5DC in your neighborhood. You can choose to host your club at the time of day that works best for you and your community. We have led morning, afternoon and evening clubs and had great success with all of them. If you need help deciding on a specific time or location, please let us know. Currently, we have spots available for the following weeks:

Week #1	June 8 - 12	Near Nuuanu on Oahu.
Week #2	June 15-19	Oahu.
Week #3	June 22-26	Oahu.
Break	June 29-July 3	Oahu.
Week #4	July 6-10	Oahu.
Week #5	July 13-17	Oahu

## How much does it cost to host a club?

CEF of Hawaii provides trained teens to lead 5-Day Clubs at no cost to churches or host families. It is our pleasure to help you reach the children in your community through our fun and engaging backyard Bible clubs. We do recommend that hosts provide a light snack for children who attend, so that would be the only expense to take into consideration.

## Where can a 5-Day Club be held?

We are willing to lead 5-Day Clubs in a variety of locations. In the past, clubs have been held in backyards, parks, churches and community centers. Basically, anywhere we can safely gather a group of children. Ideally, locations will provide an opportunity for unchurched children to participate in a club and hear the Gospel. Some locations, like public parks or community centers may require advanced reservations. Please contact Matt Walton if you have any questions about a particular location.

## Who can attend a 5-Day Club?

Our clubs are usually attended by children ages 5 to 12. However, younger children are welcome to attend with supervision and older children often tag along as well. Our desire is for as many children as possible to hear about Jesus and enjoy the club.

## What commitment will I have to make as a host?

We ask the hosts of our 5-Day Clubs to commit to the following six things:

1. Provide or reserve a locaton for the 5DC to be held
2. Recruit a group of volunteers to pray for the club and all of those who will participate.
3. Call Maureen Finnegan to arrange dates & times.
4. Invite the children and families in your community to attend.
5. Provide snacks for the children who attend.
6. With your church's help, commit to following up with the children who attend the club
