## What to Bring to Camp Good News 2025

## **The Essentials:**

PLEASE put your child's name on as many of these items as possible to avoid confusion when it come
time for packing up after camp concludes. A simple piece of tape (masking or painters) and a sharpie
marker are great for this purpose.
☐ Bible ( <i>Please put your name on the inside.</i> )

Ш	Bible (Please put your frame on the inside.)
	Pen, pencil, highlighters
	Twin Sheets (top and bottom) and sleeping bag or blanket. (Bunk beds are provided.)
	Pillow
	Toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothpaste, toothbrush, etc.)
	Glasses or Contact Lens cases, solution, etc. (If your child uses these on a daily basis.)
	Preferred sunscreen (spray or lotion)
	Preferred bug repellent (spray, bracelet, etc.)
	Clothes for five days (shorts, shirts, underwear, etc.)
	Pajamas (or clothes to wear to bed)
	Swimsuit (two if possible)
	Towel (two at the most please, one for showering one for the water activities)
	Any medicine your camper may take regularly or might need while at camp. (These will be given to our leaders when checking in at camp. Please put all medications in one Ziploc bag. Please include inside the bag a note with your name, your camper's name, the medications in the bag, and any dosage information needed.)
	A reusable water bottle (Hydro Flask, Nalgene, etc. with your camper's name on it).
	1 pair of closed-toed shoes that you don't mind getting dirty.
	2 pair of slippers (in case one set get's lost or breaks at camp)
	1 sweatshirt or light jacket (it occasionally gets cool at night)
	1 hat (optional, but helpful when the sun is at full force)
	1 flashlight (optional but helpful)
	A Bible! Make sure it is marked clearly with your camper's name in it.

## **Note About Electronics:**

Parents, if you choose to send your student to camp with a cell phone, tablet or other electronic device please know that their use of these devices will be limited. Also, the ability to charge any of these devices is not guaranteed, so please take all of this into consideration before allowing your child to bring them to camp. In the event your child is unable to self-regulate their use of electronic devices (namely cell phones or tablets), they may be confiscated for a period. You will be notified if an item needs to be taken away from your child and the reason why we deemed it necessary. Any devices, power cords, etc. should be clearly marked with your camper's name.
