Who May Attend?

Anyone 21 years old residing in the territorial boundary of St. John the Evangelist Parish. Non-Catholic family members of registered St. John parishioners are invited to attend.

Who Conducts the Weekend Retreat?

A Christ Renews His Parish team of parishioners who have attended a previous renewal weekend.

Is this an overnight Retreat?

No. This is a 2 day retreat, but we don't stay overnight.

What are the hours?

Arrive at St. John the Evangelist at 7:45 am Saturday. Arrive 7:00 am Sunday. Saturday will end about 10 pm and the retreat is over at approximately 3:00 pm on Sunday afternoon.

What Should I bring?

Any personal medications needed during the day. Everything else is provided-all food, drinks, snacks and retreat materials.

What do I wear?

Whatever is casual and comfortable.

How much does it cost?
