# Anthony Curton & Tilney All Saints Primary Partnership Heads News & Diary Dates

I haven't got too much to tell you about this month, as we have only been back from Easter for a couple of weeks. However, if you have been to Tilney this week, you will have noticed that the works to turn the brick shed into the wraparound care building have, at last, begun! Year 6 from both schools have been to visit Crucial Crew in King's Lynn today to learn all about safety. This visit covers lots of areas of safety ranging from fire safety, water safety, online safety and who to call for help in an emergency. I'm sure the children will come back full of excitement from this trip, as it always highlights elements of safety that the children don't know about and it empowers them to keep themselves and others safe when it is needed.

Please can we ask that if your child attends Anthony Curton and is playing on the community play park after school, that they don't re-enter the premises to use the toilets. We are finding that children are coming back into school, but no adult is aware of this, and that poses a safety risk. If there were to be a fire or other emergency we would have no knowledge that extra children are in the building. We need to keep the gate to the community centre car park unlocked after school, as children are being collected from After School Club, but children who have left school should not be using this gate to re-enter the building.

Just a reminder, that DEMAT are in the process of a name change, so if you start to see "Grace Schools" on any documents, this is still us but our Trust name is changing!

Last week, we were lucky enough to have Mr Wilkinson visit both schools with his lambs to talk to the children about how he looks after them. Each class had the opportunity to have a session outside listening to Mr Wilkinson telling them all about how sheep grow, what they eat, what the lambs need and lots of other sheep based facts. The children really enjoyed learning about the animals - and it's always nice to welcome Mr Wilkinson back into school!
