premises on site at both schools. It is anticipated that both of these projects will be completed by May 2026.

We are pleased to welcome a new cleaner to our Anthony Curton family. After a very successful interview, we are pleased to let you know that Leanne Drewery is going to be working with us to keep our school gleaming for the children. We look forward to having Leanne as part of our team!

Please continue to let the office know if children are ill or are going to be late to school. We are required to have this information so that we can ensure safeguarding and have accurate entries on the school registers. If we haven't heard anything from you about an absence for your child, the ladies in the office will contact you to ask about the reason for absence.

You will have seen a message recently regarding children coming into school wearing P.E. kits. This has evolved due to a new maths programme that we are going to be using in school. All classes will now have 2 maths sessions each day; one will be new learning and the second, called an MOT (maths on track) session will be recalling previous learning. The teachers have been trying out the new programme before Christmas and the feedback is that the children have increased participating during maths and it has been noticed that more children are believing that they can do maths! Due to this increase in maths learning, it has been necessary to change timetables and "save time" where we can (we didn't really think that extending the school day was an option!!)
