Maths: Addition and Subtraction,

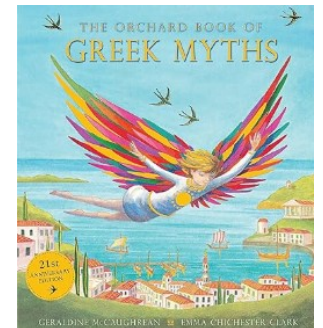
English: Greek Myths
