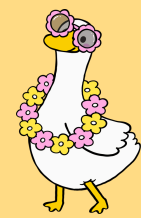

WHAT WE'RE LEARNING



Literacy

This half term we will be focusing on texts about the King and the Royal family!

Next half-term we will learn about stories from the past and have a go at writing our own stories.



Topic

This half-term our topic is all about Kings and Queens. We will learn about the King and his family, London, and kings and queens of the past.

In the second half-term we will learn about fairy tales, stories from the past and fables.



Maths

This half term in maths we will be learning about combining numbers to make bigger numbers within 10.

Next half-term we will be learning about number bonds to 10 and counting beyond 10.

IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENTS
