Welcome back to school for Spring term 2026. Mrs Harvey and I are very much looking forward to helping the children with their continued progress and to enjoy all aspects of school life.

The topic area for Geography in this term is called Eastern Europe. Following on from studying Mediterranean Europe, children will extend their knowledge of Europe by looking in closer detail at this region.

In History, the children will study Life in Ancient Rome. This unit covers the National Curriculum requirement to study the Roman Empire and its impact on Britain.

In Science, we will recognise that environments can change and that this can sometimes pose dangers to living things. The children will construct and interpret a variety of food chains, identifying producers, predators and prey.
