SSC Guidance Notes for Applicants:

- 1. Members are normally elected during the normal monthly Committee Meeting. No money needed until accepted.
- 2. Membership is effectively family membership, covering you the principal Member, together with your partner/spouse and any children *under* 18 (cadets). There is a separate scheme for those over 18 and still in full-time education.
- 3. Copies of all Club rules & policies are available in the Clubhouse & on the Club website.
- 4. Due to limited availability there may be a waiting list for moorings or storage.
- 5. Applicants with cruisers who intend to lay-up at the club will require suitable, serviceable yard trolleys.
- 6. Due principally to the restricted size of our launching ramp, the maximum size for a cruiser is 23ft LOA.
- 7. The charge for a cruiser includes a mooring position (but **not tackle**. That is the responsibility of the Member), plus a dinghy kept ashore as a tender.
- 8. Members are responsible for their own mooring tackle. If, after the compulsory annual inspection (included in the fees) the mooring tackle is found to be unfit for use, the Club will not assist in launching & will require remedial work to be carried out before the mooring can be used.
- 9. At all times it is for members to decide whether their craft, equipment & crew are fit to sail in the prevailing conditions.
- 10. Third party insurance to the sum of at least £2 million is mandatory for all craft.
- 11. To comply with the conditions of the Car Park License, the Club is required to maintain details of members' cars. Please ensure you display your car park permit & inform the Club of any changes.
- 12. Car Park, Club gate and clubhouse codes change every membership year (at the end of February). Codes issued ONLY after receipt of ALL dues & other required data, including boat insurance information.
