SSC Guidance Notes for Student Applicants:

1. All Members are normally elected during the monthly Committee Meeting.
2. Student Membership allows young persons (of any level of experience) who have reached the age of 18 (meaning they cannot be covered by our normal family membership) to access SSC facilities at a cost that may better reflect their likely low income. The discount is applicable to the basic annual membership fee only, together with waiving of the normal joining fee. All other charges remain. *A student member isn't allowed to sign in guests.*
3. Club rules & policies are available in the Clubhouse & on the Club website.
4. Due to limited availability there may be a waiting list for moorings or storage.
5. Applicants with cruisers who intend to lay-up at the club will require suitable, serviceable yard trolleys.
6. Due principally to the restricted size of our launching ramp, the maximum size for a cruiser is 23' LOA.
7. The charge for a cruiser includes a mooring position (but not tackle), plus a dinghy tender kept ashore as a tender.
8. Members are responsible for their own mooring tackle. If after the compulsory annual inspection (included in the fees), the mooring tackle is found to be unfit for use, the Club will not assist in launching & will require remedial work to be carried out before the mooring can be used.
9. At all times it is for members to decide whether their craft, equipment & crew are fit to sail in the prevailing conditions.
10. *Third party insurance in the sum of at least £2 million is mandatory for all craft. You must share your insurance details with the Club.*
11. To comply with the conditions of the Car Park License, the Club is required to maintain details of members' cars. Please ensure you display your car park permit & inform the Club of any changes.
12. *Car Park, Club gate & clubhouse codes change every membership year (at the end of February). New codes will be issued ONLY after receipt of ALL dues & other required data, including boat insurance information.*
