

PASTOR'S LETTER

Dear Parishioners of Pope Saint John XXIII Faith Community,

As we enter into the 23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time, the Liturgy of the Word invites us to reflect on whether we are bound by the attractions of this world. The first reading reminds us of how the corruptible body can burden the soul and weigh down the mind. In the Gospel, Jesus challenges us to place God's love and our heavenly home as our highest priority, rather than putting people or things ahead of God and neighbor. Let us pray for the grace to turn away from earthly distractions and keep our hearts focused on our salvation and the salvation of others.

This month marks the beginning of a new academic year for our preschool, school, and religious education programs. My gratitude goes out to our staff, volunteers, and parents who faithfully support this ministry year after year. If you have not yet registered your children or grandchildren for CCD or OCIA, please do so soon. A special word of thanks goes to Monty for organizing and leading the Catechist Workshop on September 6, which provided both new and experienced faith formation teachers with encouragement and tools to hand on the knowledge of our Catholic faith.

After the summer break, all our parish staff gathered last Friday to evaluate, plan, and share ideas for strengthening our service. I am deeply grateful for their readiness to step in whenever a need arises and for their dedication to our faith community. In the coming weeks, I will also be meeting with the Pastoral and Finance Councils to plan for the year ahead. I thank every council member for the sacrifice of their time and talent in leadership, as well as the Parish Family Advisory Council (PFAC) who help us look to the future of our parish.

We also welcome Annarose Jowenson, Parish Family Liaison for the Pierce Region, who will assist our Parish Family during the Partners in the Gospel program. They are preparing a parish survey, and I invite each of you to participate next week so that your voices can be heard in shaping our mission together.

As we approach the close of this year's Annual Catholic Appeal, I encourage those who have not yet made a pledge to do so soon. I am grateful to all who have already contributed, and especially to those who supported the Food Bank drive, which continues to bless many families through the generosity of parishioners and volunteers.

Last week, we also bid farewell to Lucia Esquivel and warmly welcome Maribel Sandoval as our new custodian. Maribel, an active volunteer and parishioner at Saint John of the Woods, will be carrying forward this important service. We sincerely thank all the volunteers across our campuses who faithfully care for their assigned areas, keeping them clean and welcoming.

A special word of recognition goes to Mr. Mike Do, our Parish Facility Operator, for his outstanding work. He recently cleaned the roofs of all our school and office buildings and repainted the school buildings in a color very close to the original, giving our facilities a renewed and vibrant look, especially at Saint John of the Woods. One parishioner commented that "Mike cares for the church as if it were his own home." We also thank the Vietnamese volunteer who assisted him in repainting the walkways and railings of the classrooms. Their dedication is a true blessing for our parish community.

Finally, I thank all who helped bring our homebound parishioners to Mass last weekend to receive the Sacrament of Healing. Let us continue to pray for all our sick brothers and sisters who have asked for our prayers. Be assured of my daily prayers for your health and wellbeing.


