PASTOR'S LETTER

Dear Parishioners of Pope Saint John XXIII Faith Community,

Welcome to the 26th Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's liturgy, we reflect on the meaning of wealth. Wealth itself is not bad—it is a blessing from God. Yet, as the first reading reminds us, blessings also come with responsibility. The Gospel parable of the rich man warns us against complacency. He enjoyed God's blessings only for himself and ignored the poor man at his doorstep—the very responsibility that accompanied his wealth.

We, too, are stewards—not only of our wealth, but of our lives, time, talents, and strength. God calls us to be accountable for all that He has entrusted to us, so that we may inherit our eternal dwelling. True stewardship means using God's gifts wisely for ourselves and, at the same time, remaining attentive to the needs of others.

God calls each of us in unique ways to share in His mission. Stewardship is not simply about giving; it is about living in gratitude, discipleship, and service to both God and neighbor. I encourage you to prayerfully discern how you can share your gifts through one of the many ministries in our parish. Whether your talents are in hospitality, teaching, music, maintenance, or leadership, there is a place for you here. Volunteer forms, links, and QR codes are available in the bulletin, on our website, Facebook, and in the church vestibule.

I extend my heartfelt thanks to all who have generously given their time and effort for the good of our parish. Volunteers who have cleaned and maintained our parish grounds have set a beautiful example of stewardship. I am grateful to Mike Do and his team for repairing the root issue at the PSJ rectory, preventing water damage to the priests' residence. I also thank Lazarus and the communications team for their dedicated work in preparing Funeral Masses, even when families have had very little time to prepare. Finally, I am thankful to the many families who have transitioned their Sacrificial Offering from WeShare to Pushpay, which helps strengthen our unity as one parish family.

The Parish Office is changing its procedures for Mass intentions in order to operate more smoothly. Please make all requests for Mass intentions to Carmen Lozano at our main campus. Carmen will schedule requests for all of our parish family churches. We ask that you schedule your intentions at least one month in advance. We will try to accommodate all requests, but appreciate your help in giving us ample notice.

I am also deeply grateful to our parishioners for generously supporting the food bank. Because of you, last month alone we served 1,500 lunches, distributed nearly 300 bags of groceries, and provided bread, clothing, bus vouchers, and more to those in need. With your continued support of time, talent, and treasure, our outreach can grow even further and allow us to serve more of our brothers and sisters who are struggling.

Lastly, I warmly invite all Eucharistic Ministers, Lectors, and those wishing to serve in these ministries to attend the upcoming training sessions. Serving in the liturgy is a profound way of offering back to God the blessings we have received, and your participation will enrich our parish celebrations.

Thank you for your prayers, generosity, and faith. May the Lord continue to bless us as we grow together in charity and discipleship.




Prayer:


