



### PASTOR'S LETTER

### Dear Parishioners of Pope Saint John XXIII Faith Community,

Welcome to the 27th Sunday in Ordinary Time. We reflect today on Faith. When we speak about faith, either we have faith, or we don't. Because when the disciples of Jesus ask him to increase their faith, He responds, to increase their faith to the size of a mustard seed suggests that they did not even have a little faith yet. 




