

PASTOR'S LETTER

Dear Parishioners of Pope St. John XXIII Parish Family, Happy Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe!

Dear fellow citizens of God's Kingdom, Let's celebrate today, Christ our King. This being the last Sunday of the Church year, we focus on the final and glorious things to come! We are in the last week of November; we still continue to pray for our faithful departed. This solemnity all the more gives us the reason to pray for those who have gone before us. The first reading speaks of David, the great king of Israel who defended the people of God from their enemies. While as the second reading presents before us, "Jesus Christ is the firstborn of the dead who has delivered the people God from the darkness and death."

Through His resurrection, Jesus has confirmed our beliefs in eternal life, because He has assured in the Gospel reading today a place in the paradise to the repented thief.
