

## PASTOR'S LETTER

**"Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world." (Jn 1:29)**

Dear faithful Parishioners of PSJXXIII parish Family,

Welcome you all to the second week in Ordinary Time. Last week concluding the Christmas season with Jesus receiving the Holy Spirit at His baptism; we are called to reflect during this season of Ordinary time, how Jesus carries out the Will of His Father. The Gospel indeed continues from what occurred right after His baptism. In the Gospel today, John the Baptist points out the Lamb of God to his disciples and to the world and declares He was before him. Thus, John completes his mission, giving way for Jesus to begin His ministry.


