PASTOR'S LETTER

"Do not think that I have come to abolish the law or the prophets; I have come not to abolish but to fulfill." (Matthew 5:17)

Dear faith-filled community of Pope St. John XXIII Parish,

Welcome to the Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time. This coming Wednesday, we will begin the holy season of Lent.

As we reflect on today's Liturgy of the Word, we hear about God's commandments and the choice every person has—to obey or to disobey them. For many, the Old Testament can seem confusing, filled with laws, rituals, and prophecies that are difficult to connect with the New Testament. Yet Jesus' words remind us that the Old Testament is not merely a relic of the past, but an essential part of God's divine plan. Indeed, every law, prophecy, and detail—down to "the smallest letter or the smallest part of a letter"—finds its deepest meaning and fulfillment in Christ.

Though it may be an arduous task to read through the entire Old Testament, those who do so with understanding discover the truth that everything finds its fulfillment in Christ. "Fulfillment" does not mean that Jesus altered or discarded the Old Testament; rather, He revealed its true and hidden meaning, bringing it to perfection. What the Old Testament could only foreshadow, Jesus fully accomplished, achieving the fullness of God's plan and leading us on the path that brings us to our Creator.

I also warmly welcome you all to the grand celebrations of the Vietnamese Lunar New Year, which begin this Sunday with a special honoring of our elders. I invite our entire parish family to pray for the Vietnamese community, especially for all the volunteers who have committed themselves to making this event possible. This celebration is not only an expression of culture and tradition, but also a beautiful way to pass these values on to future generations.

This Sunday, we will also have a fundraiser Mass and lunch at St. Rita. I thank and pray for all the members of the community who have organized this event, and I thank all the parishioners who will attend and support this celebration beginning at 1:00 PM.

As mentioned, we begin the holy season of Lent this Wednesday. I trust that many of you have returned your palms in preparation for the ashes. Masses will be celebrated at all locations. I invite everyone to read the bulletin carefully for Mass times at each location and to plan ahead so that you may begin this sacred season prayerfully.

Once again, I urge everyone to cooperate with the PFAC as they work to help us become one parish family more effectively, considering the most viable options that will assist our priests and staff in serving you in the best way possible. As this concerns our future, I encourage all of you to be more involved and to respond thoughtfully to the Advisory Council.

Thank you to our Operations Staff for installing Populife key boxes at both the PSJ and SJOW campuses, making access easier and more secure for volunteers, retreat groups, and facility rentals while keeping keys safely organized. I am also grateful to our Facilities team for inspecting and repairing all the broken pews in the church—your care and dedication help keep our worship space safe, welcoming, and beautiful for everyone. Please treat our church as your second home by helping children avoid playing with contribution envelopes and hymn books, and by collecting any trash around you after Mass.

Wishing the Vietnamese community a Happy New Year, filled with God's blessings and prosperity, I also pray for God's abundant blessings upon every member of this faith community.

What is Lent? Wednesday, February 18, 2026 - Thursday, April 2, 2026

Lent is a 40 day season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving that begins on Ash Wednesday and ends at sundown on Holy Thursday. It's a period of preparation to celebrate the Lord's Resurrection at Easter. During Lent, we seek the Lord in prayer by reading Sacred Scripture; we serve by giving alms; and we practice self-control through fasting. We are called not only to abstain from luxuries during Lent, but to a true inner conversion of heart as we seek to follow Christ's will more faithfully. We recall the waters of baptism in which we were also baptized into Christ's death, died to sin and evil, and began new life in Christ.

Many know of the tradition of abstaining from meat on Fridays during Lent, but we are also called to practice self-discipline and fast in other ways throughout the season. Contemplate the meaning and origins of the Lenten fasting tradition in this reflection. In addition, the giving of alms is one way to share God's gifts—not only through the distribution of money, but through the sharing of our time and talents. As St. John Chrysostom reminds us: "Not to enable the poor to share in our goods is to steal from them and deprive them of life. The goods we possess are not ours, but theirs." (CCC. no. 2446).
