# THIS IS MY BELOVED SON HEAR HIM.





## PASTORAL LETTER

Welcome to the celebration of the Second Week of Lent. We began this season last week by reflecting on the forty days of Jesus' experience in the desert. This week, we reflect on the mountain experience of Jesus' disciples. Today, in the Liturgy of the Word, we hear about the covenant that God makes with Abram, promising to make him a great nation and to give him a fertile land. In the Gospel, through the mountain experience, Jesus strengthens His disciples in their hope of a heavenly dwelling. In the second reading, St. Paul invites the Philippian community and all of us to be imitators of Christ, even in the face of suffering, in order to obtain the heavenly promises of God. It is important that we not be content only with well-being in this life, but also in the life to come.



We welcome all the Elect and Candidates who are joining us on our journey during these Forty Days of Lent. We encourage you to pray for our Elect and Candidates as they celebrate the Scrutinies during this Lenten journey. They will receive the Creed, which we will pass on to them, and they will also receive the Lord's Prayer as part of their journey. We thank Deacon Theman for spending time preparing and sharing Lenten reflections with us during this season, so that we may prepare ourselves for Holy Week. I encourage all of you to attend the reflections every Thursday of Lent after Mass during Adoration.

You are cordially invited to engage fully in this Lenten season by participating in our Lenten Retreat, fasting, praying, and performing works of charity and mercy. You are also invited to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation before daily Mass, regularly before Mass on Saturdays, and by appointment with a priest. We are celebrating the Sacrament of Reconciliation with our students in the Faith Formation Program and in our school. We thank our Faith Formation Coordinators, principal, and teachers for supporting us in organizing this.

We have received many calls from those in hospitals, hospices, and among the homebound requesting the Sacrament of Anointing and Confession. We thank our Outreach Ministers for organizing the Sacrament of Anointing for the homebound and the faithful in nursing homes. We encourage you to register in our parish so that we have your correct information (name, address, etc.) to provide you and your family with the services you need. We are very happy to serve you and cordially invite you to support our parish financially and in any way you are able.

We encourage students from the Faith Formation Program and from our Catholic school to join us for weekend Mass. We thank them for joining us, and we thank their parents for supporting them by attending Mass with them. We also thank the teachers and catechists for coming to weekend Mass to sign the Mass attendance form. The children must bring the form with them when they come to meet with me, along with their parents, for the interview. Attendance at the Sunday liturgical celebration is very important in fulfilling their preparation requirements for the sacraments.

Lent is a time for us to prepare ourselves to enter Holy Week, and especially to prepare those who have not yet been baptized as they journey toward the waters of the baptismal font. Lent is also a journey of repentance, purifying ourselves through reconciliation so that we may have peace with God and with others as we celebrate the Resurrection and new life.

Thank you for being wonderful stewards of your time, talent, and treasure, which you so generously share with our parish. Let us continue to grow and mature in faith as we build a strong, faith-filled community together. May you have a blessed week!
