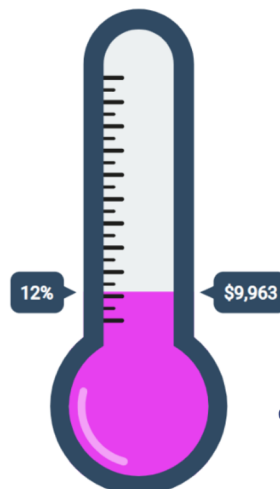

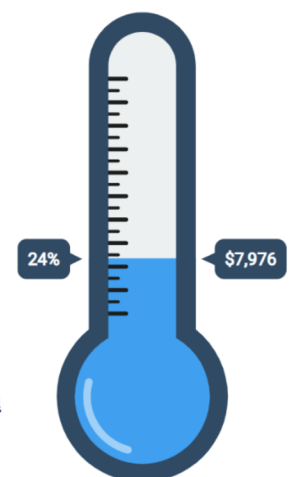

Dear Parishioners of Pope St. John XXIII parish faith community,

Wish you all Blessed Solemnity of Corpus Christi. The center and summit of Christian celebrations; sharing in the body and blood of Christ our Savior. . The liturgy of the word invites us to reflect on this great mystery. In the first reading we witness Moses admonishes the people of Israel of all that the Lord has done for them from the moment he brought them out of slavery from Egypt and how he fed them Manna in the desert. In the second reading St. Paul reminds us that our participation in the bread and wine in the eucharist is also participation in the body and blood of the Lord. In the Gospel Jesus confirms the same while teaching his disciples that, "I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world."



Though many of us have learned this teaching from childhood and accept it on some level, few penetrate the depth of the mystery we behold at every Mass. Saint John Vianney spoke beautifully of the Eucharist, revealing his profound reverence for this Gift: "If we really understood the Mass, we would die of joy." And: "There is nothing so great as the Eucharist. If God had something more precious, He would have given it to us." He also said: "How beautiful it is! After the Consecration, the good God is there as He is in Heaven." I sincerely thank all of for joining today in this celebration as well as for joining the special procession of the Blessed Sacrament on Corpus Christi. This feast nurtures our Faith in the Eucharist. Thanks to our parish core team for organizing this event!

We celebrated the Graduation Day for our eighth-grade school children who complete successfully and move ahead to other institutions for the continued education. We pray for them in a special way that God bless and lead them towards a bright future.
