Dear Parishioners of Pope St. John XXIII parish faith community,

Greetings and blessings to you all as we gather to celebrate the Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time. In the first reading, the prophet Zechariah speaks of a king who comes riding on a donkey. This king is humble and brings peace, not war. The psalm continues this message, praising God for lifting up those who fall and giving help to those in need. Paul's letter to the Romans explains that life in Christ is guided by the Spirit. It is the Spirit who gives true life and freedom. The readings show Jesus as a humble and peaceful king. 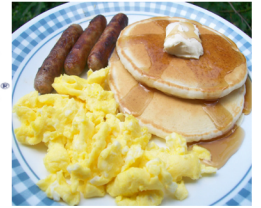

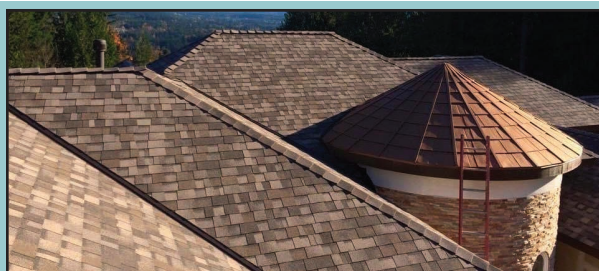
