Faith Formation Student Expectations

Our Faith Formation program exists to help young people grow in their relationship with Jesus Christ, deepen their understanding of the Catholic faith, and become active members of our parish community. To ensure a safe, respectful, and productive learning environment, all students are expected to adhere to the following expectations:

Attendance

- Regular attendance is essential for successful participation in the Faith Formation program.
- Students may not exceed **three (3) unexcused absences** during the Faith Formation year.
- Absences due to illness, family emergencies, school-related activities, or other circumstances approved by the Faith Formation Director may be considered excused when communicated by a parent or guardian.
- Students who exceed three unexcused absences may be required to complete additional work, repeat the year, or may not be eligible to receive the sacrament for which they are preparing.

Participation

Students are expected to:

- Arrive on time and remain for the entire session.
- Participate actively and respectfully in classroom lessons, discussions, prayer, service opportunities, retreats, and other Faith Formation activities.
- Bring any required materials and complete assignments as requested.
- Follow directions provided by catechists, volunteers, clergy, and staff.
- Treat fellow students, volunteers, staff, and parish property with respect and Christian charity.

Dress Code

Students are expected to dress in a manner that reflects respect for themselves, others, and the sacred environment of our parish. While Faith Formation classes are educational in nature, they take place on church property and often include prayer, visits to the church, or participation in liturgical celebrations.

Appropriate attire includes clean, modest, and age-appropriate clothing. The following are not permitted:

- Clothing with offensive, vulgar, discriminatory, or inappropriate words, images, or messages.
- Clothing that promotes alcohol, tobacco, vaping, drugs, or violence.
- Clothing that is excessively revealing, including crop tops that expose the midriff, excessively short shorts or skirts, or low-cut tops.
- Undergarments should not be intentionally visible.
- Footwear must be worn at all times for safety.

The Faith Formation Director or catechist may determine whether a student's attire is inappropriate for the parish learning environment. If necessary, parents or guardians may be contacted to bring appropriate clothing or to discuss the concern.

Behavior Expectations

Disruptive, disrespectful, unsafe, or inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated. Catechists, volunteers, and staff will monitor and document student behavior and any incidents of misconduct.

Examples of misconduct may include, but are not limited to:

- Repeated disruption of class activities
- Disrespect toward catechists, volunteers, or fellow students
- Bullying, harassment, or inappropriate language
- Damage to parish property
- Refusal to follow program rules or directions

Disciplinary Process

To support student success and maintain a positive learning environment, the following process will generally be followed:

First Incident

- A phone call, email, or other communication will be made to the parent or guardian to discuss the concern and identify corrective actions.

Second Incident

- A meeting will be scheduled with the student, parent/guardian, and the Faith Formation Director to develop a plan for improvement.

Third Incident

- The student may be removed from the Faith Formation program for the remainder of the year at the discretion of the Faith Formation Director and Pastor.

The parish reserves the right to accelerate this process in cases involving serious misconduct, threats to safety, bullying, harassment, violence, or behavior that significantly disrupts the learning environment.
