

PASTOR'S LETTER

Dear Parishioners of Pope Saint John XXIII Parish Faith Community,

Greetings to you of this warm summer, wishing and praying for you a wonderful time of family reunion and bliss. Welcome you this week to celebrate the twentieth Sunday in ordinary time. While I wish you time of family reunion, the words of Christ in the liturgy sounds strange and louder saying, 'I have come to bring division and not unity'. It is not that God wants us to be divided, but that He wants us to choose what is right. In the first reading we witness princes trying to kill prophet Jeremiah while the court official trying to save him. It shows the constant conflict between the good and the evil. Not just in a kingdom or a nation, but also the conflict is present in families. That's the reason, Jesus is inviting us to be watchful not to be tempted even by our own family members to choose the evil.
