The company also provides various services, such as auto financing, auctions, service centers, and philanthropic initiatives. CarMax's MaxCare extended warranty option is available for any used car sold by the company, regardless of age, make, model, or mileage. With a sliding scale of cost and coverage, MaxCare can last up to five years or 150,000 vehicle miles. The plan allows drivers to take their vehicles to any licensed service facility in the US or Canada that offers a 6-month or 6,000-mile warranty on parts and labor. Over 3.8 million drivers have opted for MaxCare since its inception 14 years ago, demonstrating the program's long-term success. While considering whether MaxCare is right for you, it's essential to understand what's covered by the extended warranty and the cost breakdown. CarMax's size gives the company an advantage in offering its own warranties and service plans, which can be a better deal than aftermarket options. Unlike other extended warranty providers, MaxCare explicitly outlines what's excluded from their coverage. By doing so, they aim to provide drivers with greater ease and reassurance. If a vehicle part isn't listed as an exclusion, it's covered under the plan. Exclusions include general routine maintenance, aftermarket accessories installed after purchase, conditions caused by inadequate maintenance or misuse, corrosion, or collisions. The company covers a range of components, from infotainment systems to engine and transmission parts, under their extended warranty program. In addition to part coverage, MaxCare's plan includes various support services, such as emergency roadside assistance, spare tire mounting, emergency fuel delivery, and car rental reimbursement. Drivers can also customize their deductible amount, which affects the monthly payment. The company allows vehicle drop-off at any service center and offers a \$50 kickback for using CarMax or RepairPal Certified shops. The plan is applicable to any used vehicle purchased from CarMax, including exotic models that other providers might not cover. While normal wear and tear is excluded, MaxCare's extended warranty program provides coverage for various vehicle components and includes additional services. The cost of the plan varies based on vehicle category, mileage, and deductible, with prices starting at \$1,289 (approximately \$24/month) for a 60-day extended warranty plan. CarMax's extended warranty, MaxCare, costs around \$24/month for a truck with standard variables, but increases with annual mileage. The highest tier, above 19,000 miles/year, costs \$50 deductible per repair. Compared to manufacturer-issued warranties, MaxCare is considered good value. You can pay monthly or upfront and cancel at any time, with a prorated refund based on term and mileage. A one-time administration fee for cancellation varies nationwide, ranging from \$25 to \$75. If you sell your vehicle, you can transfer the coverage program or cancel it, with another processing fee applying. MaxCare covers repairs like alternators, radiators, or AC compressors, with an average repair cost of around \$1,368. In a scenario where a sedan's radiator fails 30 months post-purchase and the owner has a 60-month MaxCare plan with a \$200 deductible, they'd only pay \$680 toward the plan at the time of repair, saving nearly \$689 in repairs alone. When buying from CarMax, you're locked into their warranty policy and can't switch to another coverage plan later. You also have to buy a used car from them, as they no longer sell new ones. Additionally, if you get a used car from another dealer, MaxCare isn't available. However, since CarMax provides limited warranty only for a short period, investing in an extended warranty seems smart for cautious buyers who want extra protection for their investment. This is especially important for high-end vehicles that require more maintenance and repairs.
