2023-2025 Mission Grant No. 20

Sharing Christ with Women and Children in Kazakhstan

Lutheran Hour Ministries | \$100,000

LWML Mission Grant No. 20 to Lutheran Hour Ministries-Kazakhstan, "Sharing Christ to Women and Children of Kazakhstan," for \$100,000, will be used for direct outreach in local churches, holistic ministry, digital outreach through *Thred.asia*, and printed Christian resources to reach the unchurched in Kazakhstan where the proclamation of the Gospel is difficult due to harassment by non-Christian religious authorities and unbelieving family members. "We are fighting both physical and spiritual poverty," says Rev. Peter Kirby.
