Sharing Christ with Women and Children in Kazakhstan

Lutheran Hour Ministries | \$100,000

LWML Mission Grant No. 20 to Lutheran Hour Ministries-Kazakhstan, "Sharing Christ to Women and Children of Kazakhstan," for \$100,000, will be used for direct outreach in local churches, holistic ministry, digital outreach through Thred.asia, and printed Christian resources to reach the unchurched in Kazakhstan where the proclamation of the Gospel is difficult due to harassment by non-Christian religious authorities and unbelieving family members. "We are fighting both physical and spiritual poverty," says Rev. Peter Kirby.
