## **2025-2027 MISSION GRANT NO. 5 GROWING TOGETHER TO SHARE BRAILLE AND LARGE PRINT LUTHERAN BRAILLE WORKERS | \$100,000**

Reaching the Blind and Visually Impaired with Good News Imagine not being able to read God's Word because you are blind. Does the thought of knowing someone disconnected from seeing and reading about Jesus' love leave your heart broken? These are disturbing realities, and God has motivated Lutheran Braille Workers (LBW) to address and to help the Lord open the eyes of the blind. LBW has 104 Ministry Production Centers across the United States operated by over 3,200 volunteers who dedicate their time to share the Gospel. There are millions of people around the world who are blind or visually impaired seeking to strengthen their Christian faith but finding it difficult to access scripture-based reading materials. Lutheran Braille Workers provides Christian materials in braille and specialized large print for free and collaborates with other Lutheran and Christian organizations to spread the Gospel to this special population of people around the world. The goal to reach more people will be accomplished by establishing five new Ministry Production Centers and holding five related servant events, such as those at LWML conventions, Lutheran universities and schools, and district youth gatherings. Service opportunities provide everyone with the chance to grow in their God-given gifts and share the Gospel. This grant will allow Lutheran Braille Workers to produce and freely distribute approximately 10,000 additional volumes of Bibles and other Christian materials in braille or specialized large print to people who are blind or visually impaired and in need of knowing Jesus as their Savior. The funds will purchase specialized paper, cardstock, braille plates, and equipment, and help to meet training and shipping costs to support this endeavor. This project provides physical, mental, and spiritual benefits not only to the recipients of these materials, but also to all of the faithful, dedicated volunteers who produce and distribute God's Word to the visually impaired.
