**The Story of Hubert H. A.
Kleiboeker's WWII Experiences**
From Colmar, France to Utweiler,
Germany

Hubert Kleiboeker was the only member of the Freistatt Community to give his life in World War II. Born on 22 December 1922, he was drafted at the age of 21 in the summer of 1944. He traveled to France in January 1945 and was immediately sent into combat as a rifleman in the 7th Infantry Regiment. On March 15, he was killed, the day his regiment first crossed the border into Germany.

Learn the complete story of his time in Europe compiled from his many letters he sent home, historical records, as well as books and articles written by his fellow F Company soldiers. Dennis Kruse, Hubert's nephew, will present the story including recent findings from his 2026 visit to Colmar and Utweiler.

All are invited to join this event, coordinated with the American Legion Hubert H. Kleiboeker Post (0419) and Trinity Lutheran. It will be held at 6:30 pm on Monday September 21, 2026, at the Freistatt School Fellowship Hall.

**Trinity's First Teacher:
Historical Presentation**

September 20 at 5:00pm
at the school following the church concert;
sandwiches and light hors d'oeuvres served

Please join us on Sunday, September 20, 2026 at 5:00pm in the Fellowship Hall (School Cafeteria) for a special presentation on Freistatt's very first teacher, Henry Nehrling. He and his family spent only a short time in Freistatt, from 1882-1887. But he did incredible things while he was here including writing and negotiating the publication of two books on North American bird life!

Dennis Kruse, a relative of our local Kleiboeker Freistatt families, will share his research and recent presentation on Nehrling, which he gave at the Society for German American Studies Conference in Milwaukee last year. Dennis has some incredible history of this Lutheran parochial teacher. Through his detailed collection of native bird behavior in Freistatt and other places - especially their arrival and departure dates of their migrations - Nehrling became an internationally known ornithologist, museum director and horticulturalist. Henry Nehrling's life, after he left Freistatt, was unknown to anyone in Freistatt, until Orville Osterloh, a long-time resident of Freistatt moved to Florida and uncovered the story in 2022.

An original copy of Nehrling's 2-volume seminal work, "Our Native Birds of Song and Beauty" (1893 and 1896) with 28 mentions of Freistatt will be available at the talk for viewing. Nehrling avoided technical jargon and depicted his subjects in eloquent detail, seeking "to inspire our young people with a tender regard for the feathered minstrels of our woodlands, fields, meadows, groves and gardens."
